Your OEF/OIF Team consists of a dedicated staff of Physicians, Psychiatrists, Social Workers, Patient Advocates, and Case Managers. Your OEF/OIF Team will be there to answer any questions concerning your transition from active duty to VA healthcare. Many other staff from the VA Tennessee Valley Healthcare System, will be present to answer questions and provide information. VA staff will be present to assist with enrolling veterans for healthcare.

Meet with the people who actually handle your VA Disability Claims from your State's Regional Office.

Representatives from the Veterans Benefits Administration Offices will be represented. These representatives will be available to assist with claim information and provide up to date information on the 9/11 GI Bill.

Meet with Representatives from Multiple Community Agencies.

There will be representatives from veteran service organizations, colleges and participants that will provide you needed information. FROM NASHVILLE:

Take 1-40 W/1-65N to I-24W (Signs for I-24/Clarksville). Continue on I-24W 40.1 miles. Take exit 4 for US-79 toward (Clarksville/Guthrie). Take slight left at Guthrie Hwy/TN-13/US-79. Continue on Guthrie HWY/TN-13 for 2.3 mi. Turn right at 101st Airborne Division Pkwy/TN-374 (Proceed through Gate #1).

FROM WEST (MEMPHIS/JACKSON):

1-40E to Nashville 76.1 mi. Take exit 87 toward McKenzie/Huntingdon, continue straight. Turn Left at Hwy-70 E/TN-1/US-70E, 28.6 mi. Turn left at US-70/Veterans Dr N, 0.6mi. Slight right toward TN-77/veterans Dr. N.. Turn Left at Huntingdon McKenzie Rd/TN-22, go 8.8 mi. Take the ramp onto Highland Dr./Tn-76/Tn-79/US-79, 15.7 mi. Turn right at TN-356/TN-76/US-79/E. Wood St., 54.7 mi. Exit onto 101st Airborne Division Pkwy/Tn-374 miles. Enter through Gate #1.

FROM EAST (KNOXVILLE)

I-40W, 177 mi. Slight right at 1-24W (signs for Clarksville/I-24/Louisville), 45mi. Take exit 4 for US-79 toward Clarksville/Guthrie. Slight left at Guthrie Hwy/TN-13/US-79. Continue on Guthrie Hwy/TN-13/US-79, 2.3 mi. Turn right at 101st Airborne Division Pkwy/TN-374, 5.1 miles. Enter through Gate #1

FROM SOUTH (CHATTANOOGA)

I-24 W, 175 mi. Continue through Nashville I-24 W (Signs for I-24/Clarksville, 40.1 miles. Take exit 4 for US-79 toward (Clarksville/Guthrie). Take slight left at Guthrie Hwy/TN-13/US-79. Continue on Guthrie HWY/TN-13 for 2.3 mi. Turn right at 101st Airborne Division Pkwy/TN-374 (Proceed through Gate #1).

FROM NORTH (HOPKINSVILLE,KY)

Head south on Fort Campbell Blvd/US-41 toward Sunnyvale Ln. Exit onto 101st Airborne Division Pkwy/TN-374. Enter Gate #1

FROM NORTH (BOWLING GREEN,KY)

KY-80/Russellville Rd/US-231/US-68, 10.3 mi. Continue on KY-80/US-68, 15.8 mi. Slight left at E 9th St. Continue on Clarksville Rd/US-79, 27.3mi. Turn right at 101st Airborne Division Pkwy/TN-374. Enter Gate #1
