

Veterans Day Parade 2014

Rules:

1. No operable firearms are permitted on Federal property, and no discharging of any type of firearms is allowed.
2. All entries will be reviewed by the committee prior to participation in the parade. A picture, sketch and/or brief description of the entry is appreciated.
3. No throwing anything to the crowds along the parade route. Outriders will be allowed with prior approval of the committee.
4. If you are a performing group, you must perform on the parade route without interrupting the progress of the parade unless approval has been obtained from the parade committee.
5. Each entry is eligible for only **ONE** category trophy. There will be a first and second place award in each category except the musical group/band/marching groups category (this category will receive participation awards). The Grand Marshall Award will be judged by the parade's Grand Marshall(s).
6. Trophy presentations will be made immediately following the parade and we ask that you or your designee come to the Auditorium in building 107 after the parade to accept the award.
7. No sirens or horns
8. No soliciting

Upon receipt of your application, you will be notified of your parade entry number, staging area assignment and a map of the staging and parade areas.
