## **Tennessee Valley Healthcare System seeks housekeeping aides**

**NASHVILLE, Tenn.** – Tennessee Valley Healthcare System (TVHS) is hosting recruitment fairs to hire housekeeping aides in the multipurpose room of its Nashville Medical Center on Tuesday, Dec. 5 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. and in the auditorium of its Alvin C. York campus in Murfreesboro on Thursday, Dec. 7 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

TVHS has openings on various shifts at both campuses. By law, these paid positions are restricted to preference-eligible veterans. Those eligible are invited to attend either event and encouraged to bring a current resume, a copy of their DD214 reflecting character of discharge, and a copy of a VA disability letter, if applicable.

Interviews will be conducted on site at both events. This is an opportunity to work on a dedicated team in a world-class health care system serving America's heroes.
